

Kemble route

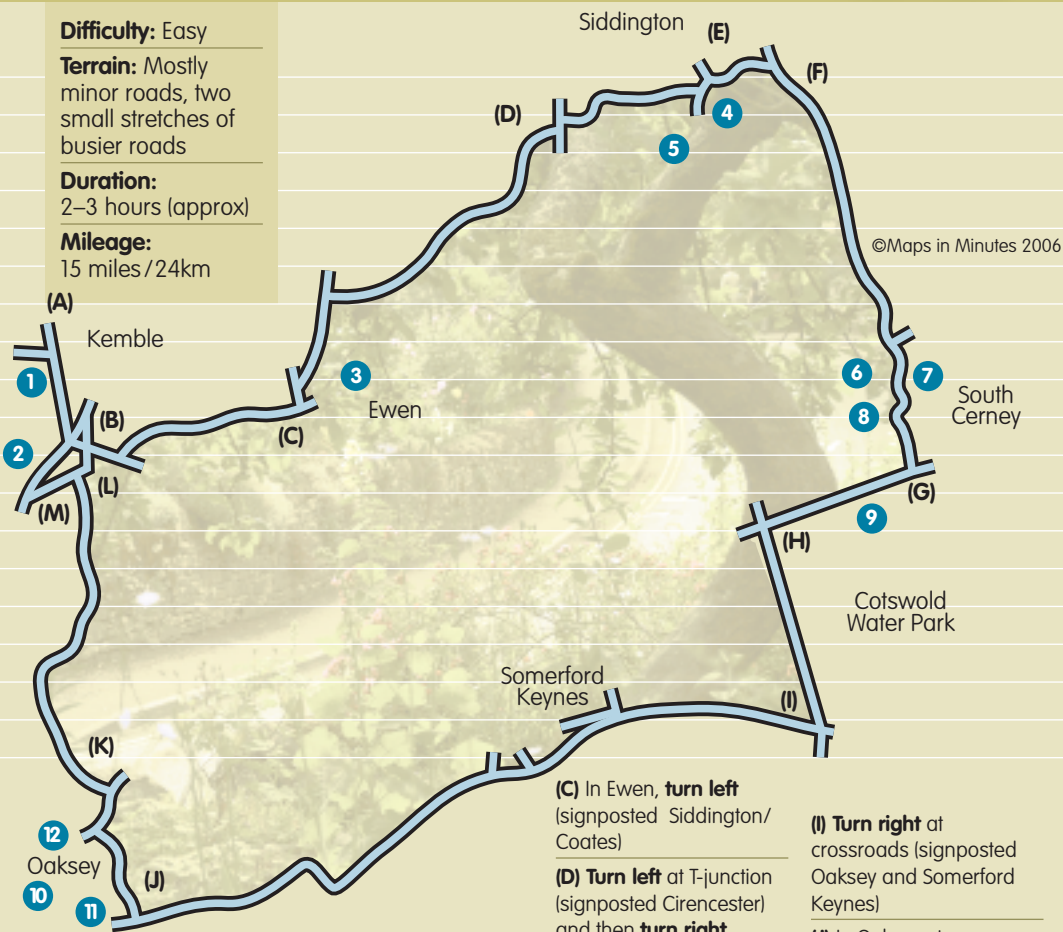


Difficulty: Easy

Terrain: Mostly minor roads, two small stretches of busier roads

Duration: 2–3 hours (approx)

Mileage: 15 miles / 24km



START at Kemble Railway Station (large car park closest to Platform 1)

(A) Turn right out of station at T-junction

(B) Turn right then **immediate left** at staggered crossroads (signposted Ewen and South Cerney). Then **turn right** and **immediate left** at 2nd staggered crossroads (signposted Ewen and South Cerney)

(C) In Ewen, turn left (signposted Siddington/Coates)

(D) Turn left at T-junction (signposted Cirencester) and then **turn right** (signposted Siddington)

(E) In Siddington, turn left opposite shop at T-junction and then **turn right** after 75 yards

(F) Turn right at T-junction (signposted South Cerney)

(G) In South Cerney, turn right at T-junction (signposted Ewen and Ashton Keynes)

(H) Turn left at crossroads (signposted Ashton Keynes/Cricklade)

(I) Turn right at crossroads (signposted Oaksey and Somerford Keynes)

(J) In Oaksey at roundabout turn right (signposted Kemble)

(K) Turn left at T-junction (signposted Kemble)

(L) In Kemble, at junction turn left (signposted Crudwell and Malmesbury)

(M) Turn left at T-junction (signposted Chippenham A429) then **turn right** to Kemble Station (note: this will take you into other Kemble Station car park)

A lovely, scenic route which is mostly on the flat. Good for the novice or leisure cyclist.
