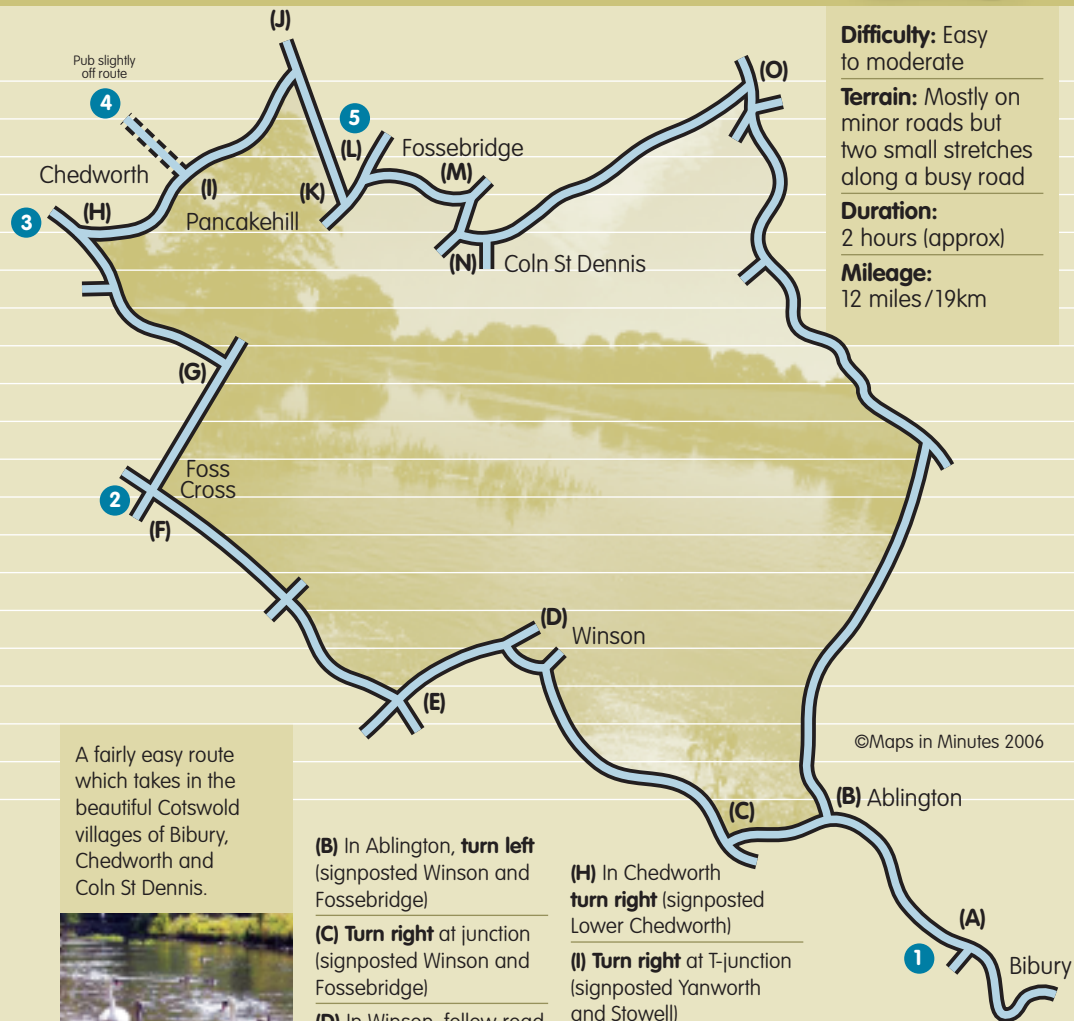


Bibury route



Difficulty: Easy to moderate

Terrain: Mostly on minor roads but two small stretches along a busy road

Duration: 2 hours (approx)

Mileage: 12 miles / 19km

A fairly easy route which takes in the beautiful Cotswold villages of Bibury, Chedworth and Coln St Dennis.



START from Bibury Trout Farm main entrance where bikes can be hired

Turn left out of Bibury Trout Farm entrance

(A) **Turn left** opposite Swan Hotel (signposted Ablington and Northleach)

(B) In Ablington, **turn left** (signposted Winson and Fossebridge)

(C) **Turn right** at junction (signposted Winson and Fossebridge)

(D) In Winson, follow road and signs for Foss Cross and Barnsley

(E) **Turn right** at cross-roads (signposted Foss Cross and Chedworth)

(F) **Turn right** at crossroads (signposted A429 Stow)

(G) **Turn left** (signposted Chedworth and Withington)

(H) In Chedworth **turn right** (signposted Lower Chedworth)

(I) **Turn right** at T-junction (signposted Yanworth and Stowell)

(J) **Turn right** at T-junction (signposted Fossebridge and Cirencester)

(K) **Turn left** at T-junction (signposted A429 Stow)

(L) **Turn right** (signposted Coln St Dennis and Bibury)

(M) At T-junction **turn right** (signposted Coln St Dennis and Bibury)

(N) In Coln St Dennis **turn left** at triangle (signposted Calcott and Northleach) then **turn left** (signposted Northleach)

(O) At T-junction **turn right** (signposted Ablington and Bibury)

In Bibury **turn right** at T-junction and **right** again into Bibury Trout Farm **(A)**
