

# Bourton route

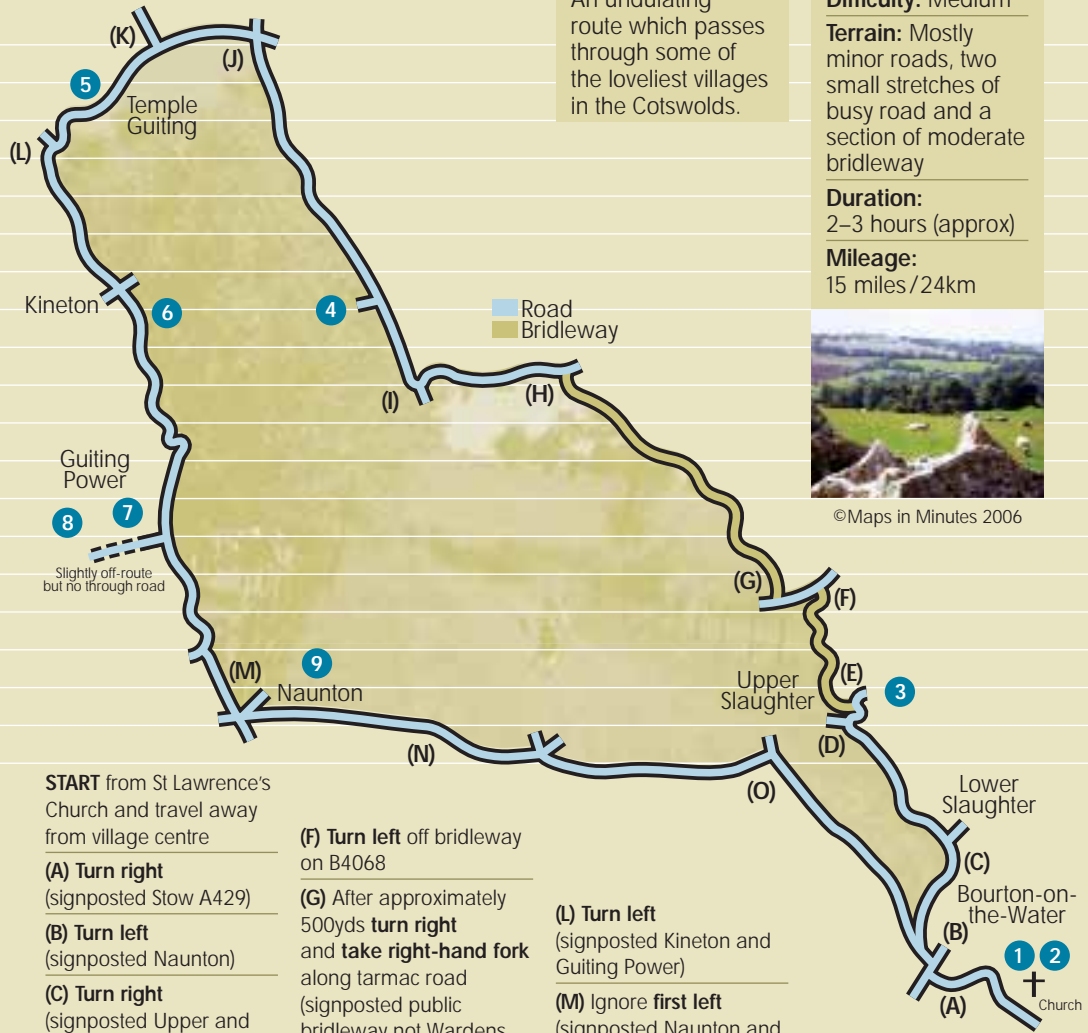


An undulating route which passes through some of the loveliest villages in the Cotswolds.

**Difficulty:** Medium  
**Terrain:** Mostly minor roads, two small stretches of busy road and a section of moderate bridleway  
**Duration:** 2–3 hours (approx)  
**Mileage:** 15 miles / 24km

**START** from St Lawrence's Church and travel away from village centre

- (A) Turn right** (signposted Stow A429)
- (B) Turn left** (signposted Naunton)
- (C) Turn right** (signposted Upper and Lower Slaughter)
- (D) Turn right** (signposted Upper Slaughter and Lower Swell)
- (E) Turn left** at car park in Upper Slaughter. At phone box **turn left** onto bridleway (signposted no through road – Wardens Way)

- (F) Turn left** off bridleway on B4068
- (G) After approximately 500yds turn right and take right-hand fork** along tarmac road (signposted public bridleway not Wardens Way)
- (H) Turn left** off bridleway
- (I) Turn right** (signposted Snowhill)
- (J) Turn left** (signposted Tewkesbury B4077)
- (K) Turn left** (signposted Temple Guiting)

- (L) Turn left** (signposted Kineton and Guiting Power)
- (M) Ignore first left** (signposted Naunton and Stow-on-the-Wold) and instead take **second left** (signposted Naunton and Stow-on-the-Wold)
- Turn left** (signposted Stow B4068) **then immediate left** (signposted Naunton)
- (N) At crossroads** (signposted Stow and Cheltenham)

**go straight over and take left hand fork up hill**  
**(O) Turn right** (signposted A429) and **take immediate left** into Bourton-on-the-Water
