## Jump2Start

Jump2Start provides advice and assistance for those in employment, seeking employment or undertaking work based training.

## Jump2Ed

Jump2Ed provides assistance to 16-19 year olds wanting to get further education or training but with no access to transport.

Jump2AdEd provides assistance to 'Adult Education in Gloucestershire' learners (community based learning for age 19+) to help them access education and training opportunities, primarily in the North Cotswolds.
